Editorial




We hope this newsletter provides a better dissemination of the project. We appreciate any comment and also more reports on your activities.

SUMMARY:

I.Reggiani on behalf of USGM explained the aims of the meeting. She explained that all the partners should have an overview of all the "in progress" activities and all the expected results in the next few months.

USGM will share the updated action plan to the EU Project Officer (PO). They will have a meeting with the Project officer in the next few days. It will be important to show to the Project Officer a realistic scheduling and all the specific deadlines for each deliverables.

The EU project Officer will make an ongoing assessment, he is unfortunately entitled to reduce the funding in case of not satisfactory or not completed outcomes.
